Stewardship Sunday is coming October 27

But, what is it? Good question...

Stewardship is a lifestyle. It is "what we do after we say we believe." It is discipleship in action. Congregations that approach financial stewardship from a biblical perspective do not view the money Christians give to their church merely as a way to pay its bills. Rather, they see financial contributions as a way to help people grow spiritually in their relationship with God by supporting their church's mission and ministry with a percentage of their incomes.

"Consecrate" literally means to dedicate to sacred service. That means that in the process of giving, we get to consecrate (our lives) to sacred service (to Christ). *Stewardship Sunday* is based on the biblical philosophy of the need of the giver to give for his or her own spiritual development, rather than on the need of the church to receive. Instead of treating people like members of a social club who should pay dues, we will treat people like followers of Jesus Christ who want to give unselfishly as an act of discipleship.

Stewardship Sunday encourages people toward proportionate and systematic giving in response to the question, "What percentage of my income is God calling me to give?" During morning worship on Consecration Sunday, October 27, we are asking our attendees and members to make their financial commitments to our church's missionary, benevolent, and educational ministries in this community and around the world.

During morning worship on October 27th; I will conduct a brief period of instruction and inspiration, climaxed by members making their commitments as a confidential act of worship. Please even if you decide

WHO ARE UNITED METHODIST WOMEN?



Then there is the FUN PART...


- 10/12 Saturday: All Volunteers need to be at the Church by noon.
