Thank you Women in Faith for the contribution toward the purchase of yarn for the "Hat not Hate" blue hat project for Willard Elementary School.

Anyone who would like to knit, crochet, or loom blue hats please let me know. I now have a supply of yarn, if you need some.

We have made 58 hats during the month of April. Our goal is 60 plus hats every month until October. Let's keep those needles working.

After some product testing, I am recommending that you measure 6" instead of 5" on a child's size hat before starting to decrease. When making a hat with cuff, maike it 7 - 71/2 " before decreasing. I am impressed by those of you who are just learning or relearning these skills in order to participate. You are such an inspiration to us all.
