When Elijah was depressed and felt very alone, he was looking for the voice of God. God's voice was not found in the wind, the earthquake, or the fire. WHAT AN HONOR / Special Mission Recognition is one of United Methodist Women's five channels of Mission Giving. It is unrestricted, undesignated funds available for use in all parts of the national and international program of United Methodist Women. Some conference United Methodist Women give Special Mission Recognitions to outgoing leadership team members. It's an honor to serve as a United Methodist Women officer, but it's a special honor to be recognized with a pin - and with funds for mission given in our names.

But don't stop at just honoring outgoing leadership team members with a Special Mission Recognition; consider all of the people, both women and men, United Methodist Women members or not, to whom you want to show love and appreciation. Some suggestions are a supportive pastor, someone who has led a mission study or retreat, homebound church members, supportive spouses and family members, close friends, prayer partners, a community volunteer, a helpful church staff member, event organizers and volunteers, a young person in your church who has shown special interest in mission work, or a deaconess in your annual conference. The list could go on and on!

Special Mission Recognition honorees receive a certificate and a beautiful gold, oval lapel pin to wear with pride. They also receive the joy of knowing that ministry with women, children and youth was supported because of dollars given in their names.

Special Mission Recognition pins are ordered via your unit, district or conference United Methodist Women treasurer. They are available for \$40 (basic pin), \$60 (pin with sapphire), \$100 (pin with a pearl), \$200 (pin with an emerald), \$500 (pin with a ruby), \$1,000 (pin with a diamond), or \$2,000 (pin with two diamonds). Units or individuals can order Special Mission Recognitions. What an honor it is to receive and to give Special Mission Recognition!

The next meeting of Fowler United Methodist Women will be at noon on September 2 in Corinthian Hall. Bring a sack lunch and join us for our program, a recap of Mission u.
